Rules for your stay at the Moose Hut

revised Dec. 2021

The Moose Hut is available for both day use or overnight guests. All overnight bookings must be done through Duncan. Read the Moose Hut Policy for updated terms for booking and the fee schedule.

In these COVID winters, follow current Public Health Orders regarding group size, sanitation, singing out loud (that's a joke), etc. As expected in all the club's buildings/facilities, surfaces (table, benches, mattresses, touch points, etc.) must be sanitized when you arrive and before your leave. Use the spray sanitizer provided. Bring your own cleaning rags.

Keep the cabin clean and pack out all garbage. Do not leave food accessible to rodents. Sweep the floors often, and close doors and windows when you leave.

Use the wood stove as needed, but conserve firewood. Leave kindling and firewood inside the hut (near the stove so it can dry if it's a bit moist) for the next guest.

Every rustic cabin has an outhouse close by. Keep the Moose Hut outhouse clean—swept and no litter.

You will need to bring:

- ✓ rags for cleaning/sanitizing
- ✓ dish towels/cloth
- ✓ eating and drinking utensils
- ✓ sleeping bags
- ✓ propane canister bottle
- ✓ 8 D-cell batteries (may be required for lantern)

Moose Hut provides:

- ✓ wood stove and firewood
- ✓ 2-burner Coleman propane stove
- ✓ Coleman LED lantern
- ✓ 6 sleeping pads and several insulites
- ✓ pots and pans
- ✓ wash basin and dish soap
- ✓ first aid kit, hand sanitizer, fire extinguisher, emergency blankets

If there are any issues with supplies (like hand sanitizer or toilet paper), or if there are other problems with the Hut (repairs, or other concerns), let Duncan or a ski club executive member know.
